

## More and more users and visitors




Interest of users for taking over part of the management responsibility



2008 Rojc Coordination established, public-civil society joint management body made of 3 representatives of Rojc NGOs and 3 representatives of the Town of Pula



2009 collective action: Rojc users protest against this refusal of the Town to recognise the hybrid management model



Coordination recognised and functional, plans for further imporovement of the model

110 civil society organizations, maintenance of the building paid from the Town budget





Organizations: 34 art and culture, 22 sport and recreation, 10 national minorities, tecnical culture 4, war veterans 5, psyco-social work 10, children and young 10, other 13







Democratic procedure, transparent management of public funds, no commercialization pressure.

A new hybrid management model, which can be easly copied and implemented in other cases and places.
